Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

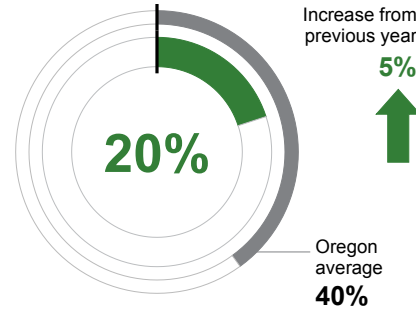

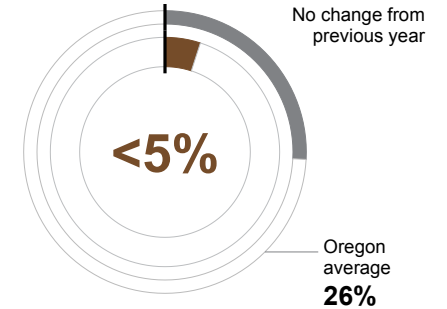
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

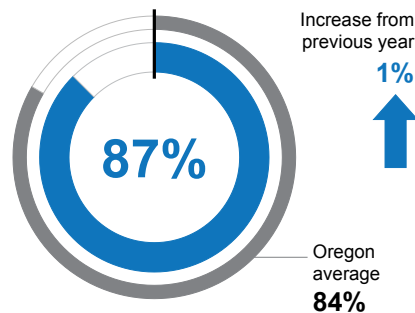

High School Success

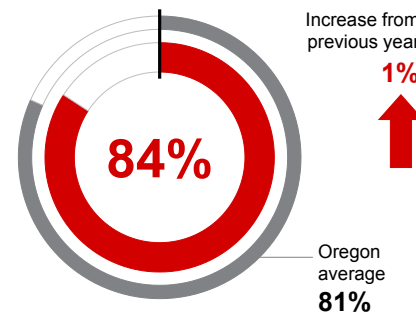
ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.



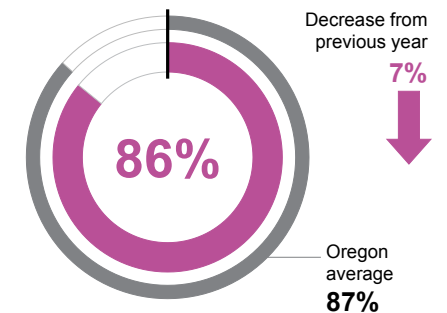
ON-TIME GRADUATION

The K-12 vision for Willamina School District includes three priorities; **Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum (GVC):** A GVC ensures that all students have an equal opportunity to learn.

Effective Instruction: High-quality instruction must be the norm and not the exception within schools and across the district.

Focus on Literacy: Literacy includes the ability to read, discuss, and write in the analytical, explanatory, and especially argumentative mode in every course.

With these actions, we can make dramatic improvements in schools.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

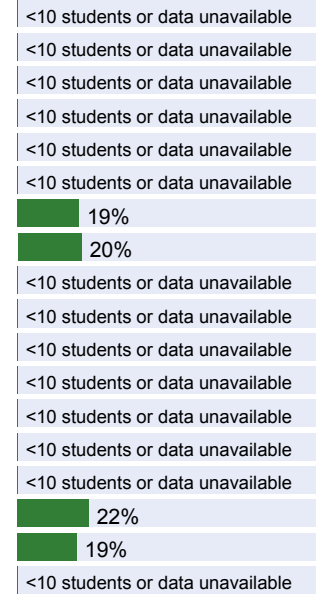

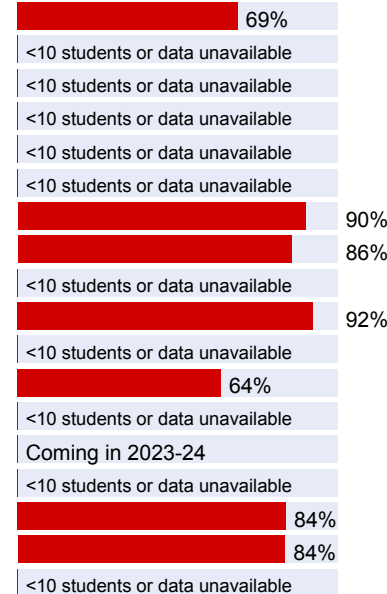

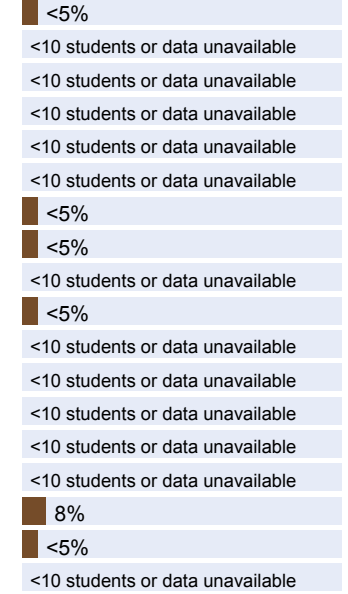
